
- Read all instructions carefully and completely before assembly and use.
- Retain for future reference.
- Keep plastic bags and small parts away from children.
- DO NOT use power tools.
- DO NOT overtighten hardware.
- Periodically check hardware and re-tighten as necessary.
- DO NOT use product if any component becomes damaged.
- For residential (non-commercial) use only.
- Max Weight Limit = 75 lb.
- DO NOT sit or stand on product. Use only for intended purpose.

Pre-Assembly


Number of people required for assembly: 1

To avoid damage to product during assembly, please take the following precautions:


- 1. Assemble on soft surface such as carpet or cloth to prevent damage during assembly.
- 2. Tighten all bolts completely once all parts and hardware have been correctly assembled.
- 3. Review below Cam Lock assembly diagram.




Insert Cam Bolt (C) into Top Panel (part #1) Using Allen Wrench (E) as shown.

*** Do not overtighten Cam Bolt. ***





- Insert Wooden Dowel (A) into the Side Panel (part #3) as shown below.
- Next, line up the Wooden Dowels to the Top Panel (part #1) and make sure the Cam Lock holes are facing inwards.
- Insert Cam Lock (B) into the Side Panel (part #3). Cam Lock must be inserted flush against the Side Panel before tightening. Use the screwdriver side of the Allen Wrench to complete assembly.
 *** When tightening the Cam Lock make sure to tighten enough to properly "lock" into the Cam Bolt. Reference page 3 for Cam Lock assembly diagram. ***
- Repeat same steps above for other Side Panel (part #3).





Connect Bottom Panel (part #2) to Side Panel (part #3) by Bolt (D) and Allen Wrench (E).
 *** Tighten bolts completely. ***

- Screw Legs (part #4) into Bottom Panel (part #2) as shown.
- Insert Cam Lock Cover (F) into Side Panel (part #3) as shown.





BE SURE TO CHECK ALL BOLTS ARE SECURELY TIGHTENED PRIOR TO USE.

Care and Maintenance

- Periodically inspect and tighten all bolts and screws.
- Dust rubberwood furniture several times a week with an absorbent, lint-free cloth to prevent the build-up of dirt and grime.
- Wipe up all spills promptly with a clean, dry cloth.
- Item can be cleaned using a slightly damp cloth. Use of strong cleaners and chemicals may damage the finish.
- Any furniture cleaner should be tested on an inconspicuous area before use.
