# **WARNING**


- Read all instructions carefully and completely before assembly and use.

- Periodically check hardware and re-tighten as necessary.

- For residential (non-commercial) use only.
- Max Weight Limit = 130 lb.
- DO NOT sit or stand on product. Use only for intended purpose.

### **Pre-Assembly**


Number of people required for assembly: 1

To avoid damage to product during assembly, please take the following precautions:


- 1. Assemble on soft surface such as carpet or cloth to prevent damage during assembly.
- 2. Tighten all bolts completely once all parts and hardware have been correctly assembled.
- 3. Review below Cam Lock assembly diagram.




Insert Cam Bolt (C) into Top Panel (part #1) using Allen Wrench (F) as shown.

\*\*\* Do not overtighten Cam Bolt. \*\*\*





- Insert Cam Lock (B) into the Side Panel (part #3).
- Cam Lock must be inserted flush against the Side Panel before tightening. Use the screwdriver side of the Allen Wrench to complete assembly.
  - \*\*\* When tightening the Cam Lock make sure to tighten enough to properly "lock" into the Cam Bolt. Reference page 3 for Cam Lock assembly diagram. \*\*\*
- Repeat same steps above to install part #3 at middle and opposite end positions.

Connect Bottom Panel (part #2) to Side Panel (part #3) by Bolt (E) and Allen Wrench (F).
 \*\*\* Tighten bolts completely.\*\*\*


- Insert Cam Bolt (C) into Legs (part #5) as shown.
   \*\*\* Tighten Cam Bolts completely. \*\*\*
- Insert Cam Lock (B) into Bottom Shelf (part #4) using Allen Wrench (F).

Connect Legs (part #5) to Bottom Shelf (part #4) by gently tightening Cam Lock (B).

\*\*\*Tighten Cam Lock completely. Do not overtighten.\*\*\*

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BE SURE TO CHECK ALL BOLTS ARE SECURELY TIGHTENED PRIOR TO USE.

#### **Care and Maintenance**

- Periodically inspect and tighten all bolts and screws.
- Dust rubberwood furniture several times a week with an absorbent, lint-free cloth to prevent the build-up of dirt and grime.
- Wipe up all spills promptly with a clean, dry cloth.
- Item can be cleaned using a slightly damp cloth. Use of strong cleaners and chemicals may damage the finish.
- Any furniture cleaner should be tested on an inconspicuous area before use.
